



You could always steal some of the moves from these dances and add them into your own!</p>	<p>Finally can you put together your festival? Don't forget to read your opening speech in a nice clear voice. You can do your dance, or play the instrument you have made. You could sing a song if that's what you enjoy too. You also know how to use purple mash and chrome music to help you make music too. Have fun!</p>
